

- **Black blazer with academy badge** – available ONLY from BA uniform shop
To be worn at all times on the school site unless specific permission has been given by a member of staff
- **Black V-neck sweatshirt/pullover – plain black**
A pullover is in addition to the blazer not instead of a blazer. No cardigans
- **Bourne Academy tie**
- **Black skirt (with BA initials)** - available ONLY from BA uniform shop
Various styles. Must be no shorter than 5cm above the knee and no longer than 10cm above the ankle. Skirts must not be rolled over.
- **Black trousers (with BA initials)** – available ONLY from BA uniform shop
To be worn off the ground
- **White shirt**
Long or short sleeved, worn tucked in and all buttons fastened (no reverse collars)
- **Black leather effect school shoes**
No trainers/pumps, no high heels
- **Socks**
Plain white or black, short or knee length (socks must be visible above shoes - no stripes or colours and must be worn all year)
- **Tights**
Flesh coloured or black
- **Hair style**
No extreme hairstyles or colours are permitted and hair should be acceptable to public workplace. The school has discretion in these matters—please contact the school prior to colouring.
